About Binhai

Qingdao Binhai University, established in 1992, it is located at Qingdao Economic & Technological Development Zone, which enjoys beautiful scenery and pleasant climate. It covers an area of 1,015 mu (680.05 hectares), whose floor area is about 470,000 square meters with advanced teaching facilities. Now, there are 16,000 full-time students, among whom more than 100 international students are studying in the university.

Undergraduate Courses:

(Bachelor degree education, 4 years) :

Students can get official bachelor's degree after graduation

- ① Major: All subjects provided by Qingdao Binhai University (Only Marketing / International trade major can be taught by English)
- ② Enrollment time: March and September each year

Chinese Language Courses:

All Chinese learners from all over the world are welcome. Different length of courses are offered here: short-term (1~3 month), medium-term (one semester), and long-term (more than one year) training classes. Also, three or four levels of classes are provided for different levels: introductory class, primary class, intermediate class and advanced class.

- If any groups (>5 person) want to learn Chinese in our school, we may make proper arrangement and course design service for them.
- There is an examination center (approved by the Chinese Language Council International) for HSK located in Qingdao Bandai University. Students can take the HSK examination inside the campus.

Entry level :	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have the basic knowledge of mandarin and learn the structure of the Chinese character and pronunciation skills; • Use Chinese to complete basic life and study communicative tasks. • Master 600 commonly used Chinese words and related grammar knowledge; • HSK reaches 3 levels.
Primary level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have the basic ability of listening, speaking, and reading, • Can use Chinese language to talk about a wide range of topics, • Can fluently communicate with Chinese speakers; • To grasp 1200 commonly used words; • HSK reaches 4 level.
Intermediate level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have better listening, speaking, reading and writing ability; • Can carry on a comparatively complete speech in Chinese; • Can browse Chinese newspapers and magazines, appreciate Chinese film and television programs; • To grasp 2500 commonly used words; • HSK reaches 5 level.
Advanced level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have good listening, speaking, reading and writing ability; • Standard Chinese pronunciation and intonation, • Can use fluent Chinese to express their views; • Can understand normal Chinese newspapers and magazines, television news and reports, etc.; • Can complete Chinese common style of writing; • Mastering 5000 and more than 5000 commonly used words; • HSK reaches 6 level

Deadline of Application:	The deadline of Spring term is December 30; The deadline of Autumn term is June 20	All year around, please submit application 2 months before class begins.
How to Apply	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit application materials by email (735968163@qq.com) or express delivery(see address below); 2. Receive the OFFER and the visa application form for study in China (JW202); 3. Apply for X1 visa in Chinese Embassy with the documents we have sent to you. (※※※ Students who plan to study language courses for less than half year can apply "X2" visa, please write down your planned learning time during materials preparation.); 4. Go to the hospitals designated by the Chinese embassy or consulate to have physical examination. Medical check project list can be find at 《foreigner physical examination project》 ; 5. After receiving X1 visa, please inform the university the date of entrance. (Students need to come to China within the required time of the OFFER. Anyone who cannot enroll within the required time for special reasons must inform the school in advance to get permission to put off his or her enrolling time.)
